Telegraph, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO: THE SHETLAND SHEPDOG CLUB OF GREATER BALTIMORE (or SSCGB). ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. An EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$1.50 plus a RECORDING FEE of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or member club show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (*American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.*)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ☛ Judging will be indoors.
- ☛ Extended grooming area will be available indoors. No chalking in building—covered chalking area is available outdoors under tent.
- ☛ Floor covering is required under grooming and crate set-ups. A limited number of tarps will be available for purchase for a nominal fee at the show site.
- ☛ All prizes will be awarded in the ring when judging of that class is over. None will be mailed.
- ☛ Dogs not officially entered in this show will not be allowed within the show boundaries.
- ☛ There will be no smoking on the show grounds. Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- ☛ Please help us keep our show grounds clean!!!
- ☛ Good food will be available.
- ☛ Bring your own chairs.

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING WILL BE EXCUSED.

All dogs present must be on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged.

EFFECTIVE FOR ALL SHOWS held on or after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary prior to the start of judging at the Show.
