Judges may request the ramp to judge any breed in emergency situations; if granted, unless the use of a ramp has been indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund. Junior Showmanship judges should follow the above.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**
Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Notice to Exhibitors

- **Judging will be indoors.**
- **Dogs may not be left overnight.**
- **All dogs present must be on a leash** or confined to their crates except when being judged.
- **All prizes will be awarded in the ring** to the person exhibiting the dog who shall be considered the owner or agent when judging of that class is over. All claims for prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging and the Superintendent advised at once of any discrepancy. The Superintendent and show-giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over. All trophies must be picked up the day of the show. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute any prize that may become unavailable with a prize of equal or greater value.
- **There will be no smoking on the show grounds.** Please dispose of all trash in the proper manner.
- **Please help us keep our show grounds clean!**
- **Setup will be available on Friday evening.**
- **Food will be available.**
- **Bring your own chairs.**

The Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

Crating

Crate Stacking is Mandatory for conformation exhibitors. No soft crates allowed for conformation exhibitors. Obedience and Rally exhibitors are allowed to use soft crates on FRIDAY, MARCH 3 within the designated crating area just outside of the obedience/rally ring. There will be **NO SPACE SAVING** by any means. All crates & tables must be present at setup. The number of grooming tables may be limited and no rugs, blankets or matting on floor of building.

Exhibitors and handlers are responsible for clean conditions in & around their setup.

Reminder

JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT FOR DOGS. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. It is the responsibility of the owner or handler to have the dog at ringside when its class is called.

DOGS NOT REQUIRED FOR FURTHER JUDGING WILL BE EXCUSED.
